- Use only non-foaming, non-chlorinated deteraents suitable for automatic dishwashers such as Rhima's range of detergents
- Ensure clear hose is inserted into the detergent bottle & green hose is inserted into rinse additive bottle
- For best performance connect machine to **HOT** water
- If pre-soaking do not use regular dishwashing liquid as significant foaming may result during the wash cycle

Operating the machine

INTIAL FILL AND HEATING


- 1. Close the door and press the ON/OFF switch (1)
- 2. Machine is ready for use when the TEMPERATURE REACHED INDICATOR (12) Illuminates
- 3. The WASH TANK (4) and BOILER (5) temperature indicators display the wash tank and boiler temperatures respectively

DISHWASHER OPERATION

- 1. Load the rack with plates/cups/glasses ensuring items do not overlap
- 2. Close the door and start the wash cycle by pushing and holding the START button (2) for 1 second.

Note: The 4 wash prgrams (6) can be scrolled through by pressing & holding the START button (2). When the desired program is selected release the START button (2)

- 3. The wash cycle will begin, and the progress will be indicated on the CYCLE SCROLL BAR (11)
- 4. When cycle is finished the START button (2) will flash
- 5. The washed items will air-dry within a few minutes of being removed from the dishwasher. The use of rinse additive will improve drying times




Draining the machine

- 1. To maintain good wash results, the dishwasher should be drained and refilled every 2-4 hours depending on frequency of use and level of soil/residue on items being washed. At the end of the day, the dishwasher should be drained, switched off and the door left open to ventilate
- 2. Leave the machine switched on. Open the door and remove the OVERFLOW PIPE (A) Fig. 2

DO NOT REMOVE THE GREY PLASTIC FILTERS (B) FIG. 2. THESE PREVENT SCRAPS OF FOOD GOING DOWN INTO THE DRAIN PUMP. Blocked drain pumps are not covered by warranty

- 3. Press and hold the DRAIN PUMP button (3) for 1 second
- 4. The dishwasher will automatically empty the wash tank and enter standby mode
- 5. Remove grey plastic PUMP FILTER (B) Fig. 2 and wash under running water and refit the filter and OVERFLOW PIPE (A) Fig. 2



(1) ON/OFF/STAND-BY

- (2) Push button to start cycle
- (3) Push to drain (optional)
- (4) Tank temperature display
- (5) Boiler temperature display
- (6) Cycle indicator
- (7) Tank filling/draining indicator
- (8) Filling indicator
- (9) Draining indicator
- (10) STAND-BY indicator
- (11) Cycle scroll bar
- (12) Set temperature indicator


Self Clean Cycle & Regular Maintenance

SELF CLEAN CYCLE

- 1. To run the SELF-CLEAN cycle, press and hold the START button (2) for 5 seconds and the SELF-CLEAN cycle will start automatically
- 2. On completion, drain the machine by following machine draining instructions

REGULAR MAINTENANCE

- 1. Remove the fixing screw (D) Fig. 3 to remove the wash/rinse arms. Check that the nozzles (E) Fig. 3 are not blocked with food waste. The nozzles can be removed for cleaning if required
- 2. Reinstall the wash/rinse arms using fixing screw (D) Fig. 3.
